With the start of fall, I wanted to take a moment to update you on the progress we have made with the new state-of-the-art medical/surgical pavilion on the MedStar Georgetown Campus. Thanks to the support and partnership of the GCP, ANC's and other community organizations, the District of Columbia Zoning Commission unanimously approved our plans for the pavilion in June.

On behalf of the patients we serve and our staff, I want to thank you for your support. The Zoning Commission approval represented a major milestone in what has been a positive and successful series of approvals we have received to make this pavilion a reality. At the zoning hearing, we were privileged to have many community leaders and representatives from local neighborhoods attend and provide their support for the project.

The new pavilion with 156 rooms, 32 new operating rooms, a new Emergency Department and a rooftop helipad is a critical project to serve our patient care mission. It will also include significant, new green space that will provide an open, attractive and charming landscape that matches the beautiful neighborhood for which we are so fortunate to serve and be a part of.

As we move forward and begin planning for preliminary construction activities, I will continue to keep you informed of our progress.
