The **MedStar Telehealth Innovation Center** within the **MedStar Institute for Innovation** virtually brings medical care through:

- **TeleStroke:** on-demand MedStar Georgetown University Hospital neurologists are available to assess and consult stroke patients within emergency departments across the system
- **TeleGold:** on-demand MedStar Washington Hospital Center emergency physicians are available for triage support in hospitals and two of the MedStar PromptCare locations
- **Surgical Preoperative Visits:** piloted with the MedStar Georgetown University Hospital plastic surgery team, patients are able to virtually conduct preoperative visits with surgeons
- **E-Visit:** patients can conveniently receive acute care treatment from home



The **Inpatient Rehabilitation Center at MedStar Good Samaritan Hospital** will combine all inpatient services into one highly efficient, state-of-the-art facility to include:

- New private patient rooms with a space for visitors
- More accessible therapy gym, equipment, and patient-related care rooms
