Program Info:

QUALIFICATIONS

Active Enrollment in RN School. Completed Foundations of Nursing course (or course that is equivalent)

STUDENT LEVEL

Candidate is a Sophomore/Junior within a Traditional Nursing Program OR Candidate is completing/completed 1st semester within a Non-Traditional Nursing Program

Seniors may apply if student cannot do SNE Program (i.e. School during Summer SNE program)

SCOPE OF PRACTICE

Paired with Patient Care Tech (PCT) preceptor to learn how independently care for a PCT assignment

SKILL FOCUS

Develops Foundational Nursing Skills (i.e. Patient Care Tech skills, etc.)

START DATES

3-4 cohort start dates a year depending upon available positions. Contact Talent Acquisitions for the next expected SNA start date.

SCHEDULE

No minimum hours per week. Max of 40 hrs./wk. The SNA's first priority is school. SNAs are encouraged to pick up at least 2 shifts per month.
